WHEN DO I START APPLYING FOR COURSES?



From 2nd August 2021 Year 12 students are able to create their VTAC accounts. Remember VTAC is the organisation that handles all University applications for Victoria – you do not apply directly to any of the Universities. VTAC also handles some TAFE and Private Provider applications. All Schools support their students in creating their VTAC account and applying for Scholarships and the Special Entry Access Scheme (SEAS).
