YEAR 12 VTAC APPLICATIONS ARE OPEN NEXT MONDAY 2nd AUGUST



VTAC will be running a series of online events for year 12 students and their parents. The webinars cover various aspects of the application process and are presented live so that students and parents can ask questions throughout. The sessions are free and open to students and parents from all schools in Victoria, with a specific session for those studying year 12 outside Victoria about interstate applications. There are two main types of sessions, with a variety of start times available for each to suit student and parent schedules:

- **Applying for tertiary courses (and understanding the ATAR):** provides an overview of the entire application process, including finding courses, preferences, results and offers. Includes a brief discussion of SEAS and Scholarships.
- **Understanding special consideration (SEAS) and scholarships:** provides detailed information about applying for SEAS and scholarships.

The USI is a unique identifier which keeps an online record of your education and training qualifications. **All Year 12 Students applying for courses through VTAC this year will need a USI to set up their Account.** If you have completed any vocational (VET) training in the past, you've probably already got a USI - Check here: www.usi.gov.au/faqs/find-your-usi.

There are three big reasons:

- To Set up your VTAC Account
- To receive Commonwealth financial assistance (HECS-HELP, FEE-HELP, OS-HELP, SA-HELP)
- To receive your degree, certificate, diploma, qualification, or record of achievement

Getting your USI is easy, free and takes less than 5 minutes. And you only have to create it once and you will have it for life!

2022 Pinnacle Foundation Scholarships



Value: Up to \$7,000 AUD

Open/Closing Dates: July 1, 2021 – September 15, 2021

We provide educational scholarships, mentoring and opportunities for young LGBTIQ+ Australians to realise their full potential and overcome challenges arising from their identity. Scholarships are awarded for fulltime study at public institutions of higher education in Australia, for the purpose of gaining an educational or vocational qualification in any profession, trade or the arts.

To be eligible for consideration for a Pinnacle Foundation Scholarship, you must meet every one of the following eligibility criteria:

- Australian citizen or permanent resident (proof required during application stage)
- At least 18 years of age and younger than 27 years of age on 20 January in each year for which the scholarship is sought
- Have achieved good or reasonable scholastic results given your circumstances
- Will be undertaking fulltime studies
- Identify as a member of the LGBTIQ+ community

UNIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIPS

Each year Youthrive Victoria offers a number of scholarships for Year 12 students who are planning to go to university. The number and value of scholarships we offer each year is dependent on funding and donations. University scholarships are funded by private donors, philanthropic trusts and sponsors and provide up to \$10,000 per year for three years plus transition and career mentoring and leadership development opportunities. Scholarships are awarded to Year 12 students who have leadership potential and a commitment to contributing to a strong, just, and sustainable rural and regional Victoria. Applications are open to Victorian Year 12 students who plan to attend university after they complete secondary school. Each rural/regional school can endorse a maximum of three applicants. Selection criteria include demonstrated leadership capacity or potential, financial need, desire to return to rural Victoria after graduation, community service and academic ability.

Applications are open now and close August 23rd.
