

TAFE



Did you know that university isn't your only study option after leaving school? TAFE or Vocational Educational & Training (VET) is a great way to get skilled up and ready for work, and it's often faster than the traditional university pathways. Some TAFE courses are even free!

School to TAFE

Many TAFE/VET courses have no subject prerequisites or ATAR requirements for enrolment. Some courses you can even study while you're still at school through a VET in schools program. You can also get paid while you learn by starting a School-based apprenticeship or traineeship.

TAFE to Uni

Getting a TAFE/VET qualification can also be a great pathway to university if you don't meet your dream course's entry requirements straight out of school. Many universities will accept Certificate IV and higher qualifications for entry into most courses. Plus, doing a TAFE/VET course first can be a great way to get a feel for what post school study is like.

Career Changers

If you work in the same job for a while but just find it isn't for you anymore, TAFE/VET is a great way to get re-skilled quickly and into a brand-new career. Some courses can be completed in as little as six months, meaning you can jump into your new job sooner.

ADMISSION TESTS

UCAT ANZ for Medicine & Dentistry in 2023



The University Clinical Aptitude Test is a compulsory test to apply for some degrees in the fields of Medicine or Dentistry. It is designed to help universities select applicants with the appropriate abilities and professional behaviours required to practice successfully as a doctors or dentists. It is used in collaboration with other admissions processes, such as interviews and academic qualifications. 13 of the [universities](#) in Australia offering Medicine and Dentistry will require you to sit the test. It costs \$305 (\$199 concession fee) Registrations for concessions are open now. **Test Bookings open on 1 March 2021 and close on 17 May.** You'll sit the tests between 1 July and 12 August 2022.
