APTITUDE FOR TEACHING ASSESSMENT

The Capstone Editing Textbook Grant provides funds to one undergraduate student to assist in covering the cost of their textbooks for the duration of their degree.

- You must be enrolled in an undergraduate degree
- You can be studying internally or externally.
- Domestic or international student.
- The grant is primarily for full-time students.
 If you are studying part-time, you are only
 eligible to apply if you can demonstrate
 carer commitments or a medical condition
 that prohibit you from studying full time.
- You must be a full-time student for the duration of the grant. You will receive one \$1,000 gift voucher per year for three years, so long as you are studying full-time during those years.
