Australia's First Degree-Apprenticeship Program



BAE Systems Australia and the employer association Ai Group will launch the nation's first-degree apprenticeship program in 2023.

The program will be delivered by Victoria University, and it aims to increase skilled participation in major defence projects. The program has already received the endorsement of major employers in the sector. The program will include on-the-job training combined with academic studies focused on a degree in Systems Engineering. Details of the course are currently being finalised, and applications will open later in the year for between 20-40 students for 2023.
