COURSE RESEARCH

Things to think about when looking for a University/TAFE Course



Planning on going to university or TAFE in the future? You might be feeling a bit overwhelmed by the thousands of course choices out there. Here are some things to investigate:

Study location

As well as the location, look at different universities or TAFEs and compare your options. Take a tour of the campus (in person or virtually), browse accommodation options, and read about on-campus clubs, facilities, and activities.

Flexibility & access

Take a look at other important details about the course. This includes things like whether part-time study is available, if the uni or TAFE will let you defer your studies, what kind of support they offer (e.g., for students with disabilities, career advice, etc.).

Entry requirements

One of the key things you'll need to know about a course is whether or not you're eligible to apply. So, make sure you read and meet any ATAR requirements and have the needed subject prerequisites before you apply. If you're not eligible through the standard pathway, take a look at the university or TAFE's alternative pathway options and see if there is another way you might be able to receive an offer instead.

Course fees

Take a look at not only how much the course will cost, but what your options for payment are. If you're a domestic uni student, you'll probably be able to access a [HELP loan](#) to cover course fees. Lots of TAFEs and RTOs will provide payment plans for their courses too, and in some cases, you can apply for a [VET Student Loan](#). But in some circumstances, you might be expected to pay your course fees upfront, so make sure you know exactly what you'll owe and how you'll pay for it before signing up. www.studyassist.gov.au
