
### Bachelor of Dermal Sciences

## Swinburne Claire Sorati Scholarship for Women



**Value: \$8,000 per year**

**Open Now, Close March 14, 2021**

The Claire Sorati Scholarship aims to support female students from disadvantaged backgrounds to undertake tertiary education in engineering, information and communication technologies or science.

To be eligible for the Claire Sorati Scholarship for Women, applicants must:

- be a female student
- be an Australian citizen, or Australian permanent resident
- be a commencing Swinburne student in Semester 1, 2021
- be enrolled full-time in an eligible course
- be studying on-campus
- provide evidence of having attended a government secondary school prior to commencing at Swinburne
- provide ATAR certificate or academic transcript of previous study
- submit a personal statement of 500 words or less addressing:
  - educational disadvantage,
  - commitment to study, including sound academic ability, career aspirations and a strong potential to complete the degree within minimum time; and
  - benefit that the scholarship will provide the applicant.
- provide evidence of financial need and/or educational disadvantage
- provide two referee reports outlining your suitability for the scholarship:
  - academic reference
  - character reference
