What is the Uni of Melbourne VCE Summer School?

VCE Summer School (VCESS) is a two-week tutoring program that takes place in January and aims to help VCE (Year 11 and 12 2021) students from a range of backgrounds gain a head start on their final years of secondary education. The program has a particular focus on creating a healthy study-life balance and providing tutoring on the widest range of subjects. In fact, in previous years we have had tutors for each and every VCE subject students have taken, no matter how small the subject may be. VCESS 2021 is currently planned to take place from January 11th – 22nd. **The program will run online.**

The program runs Monday to Friday in each week. In 2021, the entire two-week program costs \$50, which includes all VCE classes, subject materials, activities, workshops and focus tutoring.

For students who don't live in Melbourne, we offer our Rural and Regional Program, which provides additional activities, workshops and supports for students from rural and regional backgrounds. The program runs alongside the VCE Summer School, meaning you will be attending classes and workshops run by the VCE Summer School, as well as being a part of a group of students who participate in additional activities specifically designed to meet the needs of students from rural and regional backgrounds. The program is led by university students many of whom come from rural and regional areas, who will share their experience and insights into VCE and coming to University.

Latrobe University Destination Australia Scholarship



LA TROBE

The Destination Australia scheme seeks to attract and support new students to study in regional Australia and offers students a high-quality learning experience. This scholarship offers students from Australia and overseas the opportunity to experience regional Australia.

To be eligible to apply for this scholarship, applicants must:

- Be a new domestic student commencing their first year of study in a Bachelor degree, or Masters by coursework in 2021. Current La Trobe students who are beginning a Masters by coursework in 2021 are also eligible.
- Be studying full-time at a regional campus in a course that is offered in its entirety at that campus (Online, Diploma or Certificate students are not eligible for this scholarship)
- Be residing in any area other than **R1 classification**, or intending to move to an area other than R1 classification.

Recipients of the scholarship shall be selected by the University based on their:

- Personal statement, in particular how well the applicant addresses their commitment to studying and supporting the community in a regional area
- Evidence of academic merit*
- Evidence of disadvantage*

There are limited scholarship places allocated to each regional campus.
