TERTIARY ACCESS PAYMENT

Financial help for outer regional or remote students to help with the cost of moving for tertiary study. The Tertiary Access Payment is a payment of \$5,000. It's to help eligible students with the cost of moving to study. This is for study after you've finished year 12. Students can claim the payment via Services Australia (Centrelink) in their first year of study.

Regional Benefits Program



Our Regional Benefits Program empowers high achieving students from regional communities to live, study and thrive in regional Victoria.

If you come from a regional school and scored an ATAR of 80* or higher you are guaranteed a place in your chosen course** subject to meeting all course requirements including course prerequisites, offered at one of La Trobe's Bendigo, Albury-Wodonga, Mildura or Shepparton campuses. Your guaranteed place will include the benefits of the program and a scholarship of up to \$5,000 a year. In addition, you'll have access to opportunities and a supportive network to help you explore your passion.

*An ATAR of 85 is required to access the Regional Benefits program for the Bachelor of Physiotherapy (Honours) and Bachelor of Dental Science (Honours).

**Some courses have limited places; offers for the Regional Benefits Program in those instances are guaranteed for December round and January round one offers only.

PRE - APPRENTICESHIPS

WHAT ARE PRE-APPRENTICESHIPS?



Pre-apprenticeships are entry level training which can provide a pathway into an industry.

Benefits of undertaking a Pre-apprenticeship

- Find out whether a particular industry is right for you, without committing to a full apprenticeship
- Undertaking a pre-apprenticeship that includes work experience will help with your chances of finding work, by giving you direct experience to put on your resume
- Develop basic on-the-job skills and some industry-specific skills
- The provider you are doing a pre-apprenticeship with may be able to help you find an employer
- Some employers, particularly in the trade industries, have a preference for people who have completed a pre-apprenticeship. They see the initiative as providing a good grounding in basic skills and workplace awareness
- You may receive credit for the study completed
