From 31st July 2023 Year 12 students are able to create their individual VTAC accounts. VTAC is the organisation that handles all University applications for Victoria – you do not apply directly to any of the Universities. VTAC also handles some TAFE and Private Provider applications. All Schools will support their Year 12 students to create their VTAC accounts and apply for Scholarships/SEAS (Special Entry Access Scheme).

The USI is a unique identifier which keeps an online record of your education and training qualifications.
