### NURSING AND MIDWIFERY



Did you know that **The Department of Health is offering scholarships** as part of the “Making It Free to Study Nursing and Midwifery” initiative, to train and upskill the next generation of registered nurses and midwives? This includes scholarships for Victorian and eligible border community residents to complete an undergraduate (entry-to-practice) nursing or midwifery qualification – such as a bachelor’s degree. Approximately 10,000 scholarships of up to \$16,500 are available for new domestic students commencing an eligible program of study, between 1 January 2023 and the Semester 1, 2024 census date.
