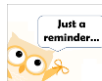

New Deakin Regional Access Scheme

The Casper test



All applicants applying for entry into an initial **Teacher Education** course at all Victorian Universities or a **Nursing Course @ Victoria University** must complete an additional selection tool for non-academic attributes - the CASPer test.

The **Casper Test** is an online, video scenario-based situational judgement test that allows students to demonstrate their suitability for a Teaching/Nursing career e.g., empathy, ethics, and collaboration. Some courses may also require you to complete the "Snapshot" – check the essential requirements for enrolment section for individual courses on VTAC. The **Snapshot** is a short, one-way video interview that further probes applicants' communication skills and motivation for the profession.

To ensure consideration for offers in the December Course offer round, you must sit the Casper Test on or before the 14th of November 2021. It is advisable that you register for the test at least two days beforehand. The fee to sit the test is \$80.00. SCHOLARSHIPS

AUSTRALIAN CATHOLIC UNIVERSITY ACCESS & EQUITY SCHOLARSHIPS



Australian Catholic University (ACU) do not use the VTAC system to handle their Access & Equity Scholarship applications, unlike the other Victorian Universities.

Because **ACU** have campuses interstate they handle all the equity scholarship applications via the NSW UAC system. You simply have to enter your VTAC Number when applying.

UNIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIPS

Each year Youthrive Victoria offers a number of scholarships for Year 12 students who are planning to go to university. Applications are open to Victorian Year 12 students who plan to attend university after they complete secondary school. Each rural/regional school can endorse a maximum of three applicants. Selection criteria include demonstrated leadership capacity or potential, financial need, desire to return to rural Victoria after graduation, community service and academic ability.

Applications are open now and close August 23rd.

Open/Closing Dates: August 14th – October 23rd

Federation University offer scholarships to Year 12 students across Regional and Rural Victoria who enrol in a Federation University Australia course on campus. The scholarships are awarded on the basis of community involvement and contribution, relocating from a regional or rural area, and supporting statement from school.

Eligibility criteria:

- Current year 12 student intending to enrol at Federation University Australia
- Undertaking an undergraduate program full-time studying at a FedUni campus in 2022
- Living in a regional or remote area
