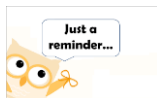

**\$5,000
TERTIARY ACCESS
PAYMENT**



The Tertiary Access payment is a payment to help students with the cost of moving from regional or remote areas for tertiary study. This payment is a one-off payment of up to \$5,000. It's to help eligible students with the cost of moving to study. This is for study after you've finished year 12 or equivalent.

To get the payment you need to meet some rules. These include:

- moving from a regional or remote area for tertiary study
- starting tertiary study in the year after finishing year 12 or equivalent.

You must be all of the following:

- an Australian resident
- meeting [study rules](#)
- from an inner regional, outer regional, remote, or very remote area
- moving to study at a tertiary education provider that's at least 90 minutes away from your family home by public transport
- have completed year 12 or equivalent
- studying a tertiary course at certificate IV or above in the year after year 12 with no gap year
- 22 or younger on the day you start your tertiary course
- have parents or guardians whose income is under the current combined parental income limit of \$250,000.

If you're eligible, you can claim the Tertiary Access Payment from 1 January to 31 December in your first year of tertiary study. For further information visit:

ADMISSION TESTS

The Casper test



All applicants applying for Education courses at all Victorian Universities, or a **Nursing Course @ Victoria University** must complete an additional selection tool for non-academic attributes - the CASPer test.

The Casper Test is an online, video scenario-based situational judgement test that allows students to demonstrate their suitability for a Teaching/Nursing career e.g., empathy, ethics, and collaboration. Some courses may also require you to complete the "Snapshot" – check the essential requirements for enrolment section for individual courses on VTAC.

To ensure consideration for offers in the December Course offer round, you must sit the Casper Test on or before the 13th November 2022. The fee to sit the test is \$80.00. For further information and/or to book visit:
