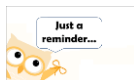

NURSING AND MIDWIFERY



The Andrews Labor Government is backing Victoria's healthcare system with free university and specialist training for thousands of nurses and midwives. More than 10,000 students will have the cost of their nursing or midwifery undergraduate studies paid for, while scholarships will be available for thousands more who complete postgraduate studies in areas of need including intensive care, cancer care, paediatrics, and nurse practitioner specialities. All new domestic students enrolling in a professional-entry nursing or midwifery course in 2023 and 2024 will receive a scholarship of up to \$16,500 to cover course costs.

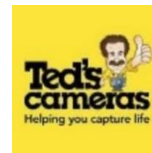
