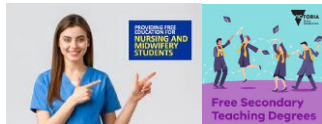

FREE SECONDARY EDUCATION & NURSING/MIDWIFERY STUDY



The Victorian government is making it free to study secondary school teaching from next year, in a bid to boost the supply of teachers. Scholarships will be available to all students who enrol in secondary school teaching degrees in 2024 and 2025.

It follows a similar commitment to cover the cost of nursing/Midwifery degrees.
