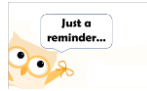

## BENDIGO AND ADELAIDE BANK SCHOLARSHIPS



The scholarship award value is \$5,000 per year. The scholarship covers one full year of study but, depending on your academic performance, it may be renewed for a second year.

**Eligibility requirements:**

- This Scholarship is for students living in rural and regional Australia.
- Any subject can be studied under this scholarship provided that it is at undergraduate bachelor's degree level in an approved Australian course.
- You must be an Australian citizen or permanent resident.
- Only first-time, first year university students wishing to study full-time in 2021 can apply.
- You must demonstrate the disadvantage (economic and/or social) hindering your ability to undertake further study.

Applications for 2022 scholarships will open 1 December 2021. Successful recipients will be notified by 31 March 2022.

**GAP YEAR OPPORTUNITIES**



A "Gap Year" is where you take a "year off" after your secondary schooling to do something else before you undertake further education and training (or full time employment). Normally, people travel, work part time or do volunteer work, or a combination of these.

It is now a common practice to defer university for a year and undertake these activities before commencing university the following year. There are a number of reasons why you might decide to do this:

- You want to take a break from studying
- You want to get some skills and experience
- You want to make some money before going on to further study
- You want to use this time to work to gain "independent status" before going to university \*\*
