Uni of Melbourne VCE Summer School

VCE Summer School (VCESS) is a two-week tutoring program that takes place in January and aims to help VCE (Year 11 and 12 2022) students from a range of backgrounds gain a head start on their final years of secondary education. The program has a particular focus on creating a healthy study-life balance and providing tutoring on the widest range of subjects. In fact, in previous years we have had tutors for each and every VCE subject students have taken, no matter how small the subject may be. VCESS 2022 will take place **January 10th – 21st 2022.**

Program Structure in 2022

Option 1 - In person component: Students will be invited onto the University of Melbourne campus to meet with peers and tutors for informal study, events, and workshops for four days during the program. There will be an organised tour of the University campus, an opportunity to attend a VCE English lecture, and various workshops focused on wellbeing, practical learning, and study skills. Students can meet with tutors from a variety of study areas to ask questions about academic content and to explore their options for future study.

VCESS offer a **residential** program for students from **Rural or Regional backgrounds** who could not otherwise attend Melbourne-based program activities. Students in the residential program complete academic classes and events with day students, additional activities and workshops, and are provided with food and accommodation for the duration of the one week program. It's a great opportunity to make friends from all across Victoria.

Option 2 - Online component: For VCESS 2022, academic classes will be delivered online through academic tutorials with a tutor and a subject booklet provided for each subject.

Capstone Editing Textbook Grant for Undergraduates



Value: \$3,000 AUD

Open/Closing Dates: March 4, 2021 – January 6, 2022

The Capstone Editing Textbook Grant provides funds to one undergraduate student to assist in covering the cost of their textbooks for the duration of their degree.

Before applying for this scholarship, please check your eligibility against these criteria:

- You must be enrolled in an undergraduate degree at an Australian or New Zealand university to be eligible to be awarded the grant.
- You can be studying internally or externally.
- You can be a domestic or international student.
- The grant is primarily for full-time students. If you are studying part-time, you are only eligible to apply if you can demonstrate carer commitments or a medical condition that prohibit you from studying full time.
- You must be a full-time student for the duration of the grant. You will receive *one \$1,000 gift voucher per year for three years*, so long as you are studying full-time during those years (you are still eligible if you become a postgraduate student during that time).
- You cannot apply if you are an employee or contractor of Capstone Editing (or a family member of an employee or contractor).

BENDIGO AND ADELAIDE BANK SCHOLARSHIPS



The scholarship award value is \$5,000 per year. The scholarship covers one full year of study but, depending on your academic performance, it may be renewed for a second year.

Eligibility requirements:

- This Scholarship is for students living in rural and regional Australia.
- Any subject can be studied under this scholarship provided that it is at undergraduate bachelor's degree level in an approved Australian course.
- You must be an Australian citizen or permanent resident.
- Only first-time, first year university students wishing to study full-time in 2021 can apply.
- You must demonstrate the disadvantage (economic and/or social) hindering your ability to undertake further study.

Applications for 2022 scholarships will open 1 December 2021. Successful recipients will be notified by 31 March 2022.
