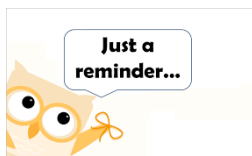

BENDIGO AND ADELAIDE BANK SCHOLARSHIPS



Value: \$5,000

(Covering one full year of study but may be renewed for a second year).

Open 1st December 2022, Close 27th February 2023

Eligibility requirements include:

- Students living in rural and regional Australia.
- Studying an undergraduate bachelor's degree in an approved Australian course.
- Australian citizen or permanent resident.
- Only first-time, first year university students wishing to study full-time in 2022 can apply.
- You must demonstrate the disadvantage (economic and/or social) hindering your ability to undertake further study.
