BENEFITS OF A TAFE/VET QUALIFICATION



Finishing school? Glad you will never have to set foot inside a classroom again? New statistics from Jobs and Skills Australia could make you think twice if you're wondering whether more education is really worth it.

1. Males with a Vocational/TAFE (VET) qualification are 12.7% and females are 15.2% **more employable than those without a VET qualification.**
2. Overall, **82.7% of VET graduates gain employment.**
3. The **median income is \$10,000 more for VET graduates** than for those without a VET qualification.
4. 15.7% of VET graduates **continue with further VET training**, while 6.7% **move into higher education** (university).
5. The courses with the highest median income and best employment outcomes are those in **engineering and technology** related fields.
