EARLY ENTRY PROGRAMS

EARLY OFFER

Early offer programs are run by the institutions, **but official offers are made through VTAC**. The only type of early offer that is made in Victoria is a conditional offer.

Conditional offers advise applicants on what criteria is required to be made a formal offer through VTAC. The criteria may be adjusted based on the early offer application. The conditional criteria of an early offer might be a lower adjusted ATAR requirement, or successful completion of the VCE.

Once year 12 results are released, early offer applicants will know if they have met the criteria or not. You should list your Course preferences in the order you want to study them. If any higher preferences want to make you an offer, you will receive an offer for your highest eligible preference over your early offer course.

NOTE: You will still only receive ONE course offer per VTAC offer round. So, if your early offer is the course you would like to study above all others, then list it as your first preference. If not, put it further down your list!
