HOW CAN I FINANCE MY STUDIES?

Study Assist

Study Assist is an Australian Government website which provides information for students about Government assistance for funding Tertiary (TAFE and University) study. www.studyassist.gov.au

Commonwealth Supported Places (CSP)

A Commonwealth supported place (CSP) is a place at a university or higher education provider where the government pays part of your fees. This part is a subsidy, not a loan, and you don't have to pay it back. This subsidy does not cover the entire cost of your study. The remaining portion is called the 'student contribution amount', the payment of which YOU are liable for. You can take out a HECS-HELP loan to pay for your "student contribution amount".

FREE TAFE

Free TAFE for [priority courses](#) covers tuition fees for students who are eligible for government-subsidised training. From January 2022, Free TAFE will expand to offer more than 60 courses, helping to address Victoria's skills and training needs for its future. www.vic.gov.au/free-tafe. If your TAFE course is not a "Free TAFE" course, you can take out a FEE-HELP loan to assist with paying your fees.

VTAC Scholarships

Most of the Victorian Universities (excluding ACU and Federation University) use the VTAC system for their Merit and Equity Scholarship applications. Simply fill out one scholarship application form, and it will be sent to all of the Universities on your course preference list.
