Did you know that university isn't your only study option after leaving school? TAFE or Vocational Educational & Training (VET) is a great way to get skilled up and ready for work, and it's often faster than the traditional university pathways. Some TAFE courses are even free!

School to TAFE

Many TAFE/VET courses have no subject prerequisites or ATAR requirements for enrolment. Some courses you can even study while you're still at school through a VET in schools program. You can also get paid while you learn by starting a School-based apprenticeship or traineeship.

TAFE to Uni

Getting a TAFE/VET qualification can also be a great pathway to university if you don't meet your dream course's entry requirements straight out of school. Many universities will accept Certificate IV and higher qualifications for entry into most courses. Plus, doing a TAFE/VET course first can be a great way to get a feel for what post school study is like.

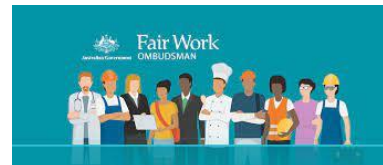

How Do You Know How Much You Should Be Paid?



So, you've got your first job – exciting! One of the best parts of work is having your own money to do with as you please. Of course, we want to believe that employers will do the right thing and follow the rules, and trust that they will pay you the right amount. But if you have some concerns, or are just curious to know, how can you find out how much you should be paid?

How much should you be paid?

The easiest way to find out how much you should be paid is to take a look at the Fair Work Ombudsman's Pay Calculator. They calculate your pay by using the **award** for your industry.
